



Dennison Rd Bridge

Project Overview

During this project the Washtenaw County Road Commission (WCRC) and its contractor will:

- Remove the existing Dennison Rd bridge over the Saline River, south of Mooreville Rd in York Township.
- Construct a new concrete bridge.
- Reconstruct road approaches to the bridge.
- Install signage, replace guardrail and install pavement markings.

Project Timeline

Bridge construction is expected to begin early March. During the bridge construction, no traffic will be allowed to cross the bridge and a detour will be posted. WCRC's goal is to complete the bridge and reopen Dennison Rd by early September 2021.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How is this project funded?

A: Funding for the project is coming from the following sources:

Q: What are the limits of construction?

A: The road approaches will be replaced, extending out from the Dennison Rd Bridge over the Saline River approximately 200 ft each end.

Q: When will construction begin/be completed?

A: Construction is expected to begin at the bridge in early March 2021. WCRC's goal is to reopen the road early September, weather pending.

Q: Will I have access to my property during construction?

A: Yes. Residents and property owners who live within the construction area will be provided access to and from their property by the contractor during construction.

No traffic, however, including vehicles, pedestrians and bicycles, will be allowed to cross the bridge during the project.

Q: Will any trees be removed during this project?

A: Yes. Some trees around the existing bridge must be removed to construct the new bridge. These removals will provide the necessary space for equipment to access the site.

Q: What roads are included in the posted detour?

A: The posted detour will include Mooreville Rd, Platt Rd and Redman Rd (Monroe County). Motorists will be required to follow the posted detour or seek an alternate route.

Q: Will area utilities be affected?

A: No. The existing utilities near the bridge are currently west of the bridge location and will not require relocation.

Q: What will happen with mail delivery and trash pickup?

A: Mail delivery and garbage collection for residents and property owners who live within the project limits will be maintained throughout the project.

Q: Will my lawn be restored once construction is completed?

A: Yes, the contractor will be responsible to grow grass wherever the ground has been disturbed as part of the project.
