



Geddes Rd Bridge

Project Overview

During this project the Washtenaw County Road Commission (WCRC) and its contractor will:

- Remove the existing Geddes Rd Bridge over Fowler Creek near Ridge Rd in Superior Township
- Construct a new precast concrete box culvert
- Reconstruct road approaches
- Install signage, replace guardrail and install pavement markings

Project Timeline

Bridge construction is expected to begin in mid-June 2021. During the bridge construction, no traffic will be allowed to cross the bridge and a detour will be posted. WCRC's goal is to complete the bridge and reopen Geddes Rd by late-October 2021.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How is this project funded?

A: Funding for the project is coming from the following sources:

Funding Source	
MDOT Local Agency Program Funds	\$ 932,000

Q: What are the limits of construction?

A: The road approaches will be replaced extending approximately 400 ft each side of the bridge.

Q: When will construction begin/be completed?

A: Construction is expected to begin at the bridge in mid-June 2021. WCRC's goal is to complete the bridge and reopen the road by late-October, weather pending.

Q: Will I have access to my property during construction?

A: Yes. Residents and property owners who live within the construction area will be provided access to and from their property by the contractor during construction.

However, no traffic, including vehicles, pedestrians and bicycles, will be allowed to cross the bridge during project.

Q: Will any trees be removed during this project?

A: Yes. Some trees around the existing bridge must be removed to construct the new bridge.

Q: What roads are included in the posted detour?

A: The posted detour will include Prospect Rd, Clark Rd and Ridge Rd. Motorists will be required to follow the posted detour or seek an alternate route.

Q: Will area utilities be affected?

A: Relocation of known utilities is required and currently underway. Service is expected to be maintained.

Q: What will happen with mail delivery and trash pickup?

A: Mail delivery and garbage collection for residents and property owners who live within the project limits will be maintained throughout the project.

Q: Will my lawn be restored once construction is completed?

A: Yes, the contractor will be responsible to grow grass wherever the ground has been disturbed as part of the project.
